Board Action—Current Status of Our Project



Upon election at the Fall AGM, the Board immediately set out to tackle their mandate. Their initial decision was to continue to "phase in" the various components of the project with the next phase being a Medical Clinic. To this end, a "Medical Clinic Committee" was established, chaired by new Board member Lionel Duruisseau.

The committee has since then been working at a feverish pace to: establish a budget for the Clinic, establish a minimum space requirement, obtain possible space lease agreements, investigate personnel possibilities. Details will be announced soon.

Simultaneously, the Capital Campaign Committee chaired by Walter Kleinschmit contracted the firm of MF1 to begin the development of materials for the upcoming Capital Campaign for the project. The Board anticipates that there will be major announcements made to our membership soon on both of these latest initiatives.
